THE FUTURE OF SOCIAL SERVICE WORKFORCE STRENGTHENING

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FUTURE GLOBAL CHALLENGES FACING THE SOCIAL SERVICE WORKFORCE OVER THE NEXT 10 YEARS

- Impact of climate change, increasing the frequency and intensity of extreme weather events, and increasing the risk of drought and famine, as well as loss of livelihoods, displacement and migration
- Impact of conflict: civil war and inter-ethnic conflict, with high impact on civilians, loss of caregivers, and resulting waves of displacement and migration
- Future pandemics with the social service workforce playing an essential role in prevention, awareness raising and response (in particular when the public does not trust official information)
- An ageing population in many countries and regions, with increasing social consequences and social care needs related to increased prevalence of dementia and other long term health conditions





PRIORITIES IN SOCIAL SERVICE WORKFORCE STRENGTHENING

- Making the case for investing in the social service workforce, in state budgets and support of international donors, including use of ratios and costing for evidence-based planning and budgeting
- Developing competency frameworks and competency-based approaches to education, training and continuous professional development
- Greater recognition and use of supportive, reflective supervision to increase quality of practice and support continuous learning and professional development





PRIORITIES IN SOCIAL SERVICE WORKFORCE STRENGTHENING

- Para professionals and community volunteers: extending standards and quality assurance frameworks, and supervision and support, to the wider workforce, including CSOs and communitybased organisations
- Extending social service workforce strengthening to cover the whole workforce, including those working with people with older people, people with disabilities and with mental health needs, refugees and migrants.
- Learning from and involving people with lived experience of social services in order to improve practice (workforce behaviours and values) and the quality, relevance and usefulness of services.
